Scholarships and Fee Assistance

Introduction

We want you to join us because you are the best, but you may need some help to get here. St Catherine's College invests \$800,000 annually in a range of residential scholarships and bursaries to provide students with the opportunity to pursue a tertiary education whilst living on campus. Scholarships vary in size and provide substantial discounts on fees.

Scholarships are awarded **only at the start of each year** to outstanding applicants who will be assessed on academic achievement, significant service to the community and sporting or artistic achievement.

How to apply for a scholarship to live at St Catherine's

Applications for a scholarship to live at St Catherine's **are separate** to the standard application process for residency. If you intend to apply for a scholarship to live at St Catherine's, you should first submit an online application on the *UWA Residential Colleges Application Portal*, with St Catherine's listed as your first preference.

Once you have completed the above, submit an online scholarship application through our website. While we have a range of scholarships, each with its own eligibility and selection criteria, you only need to complete one scholarship application form. We will consider your application for the most appropriate scholarship to you. Scholarship applications for 2018 are now open on our website and close on 30 January 2018.

Our scholarships

Prestigious Scholarships - eligibility and selection criteria apply

The top eight students accepted into the **UWA Fogarty Foundation Scholarship** program, the **UWA Bachelor of Philosophy (Honours)** program, or the **UWA Winthrop Scholarship** program, will receive a St Catherine's Residential Scholarship of \$10,000 per year **for four years**.

Submit your application to live at St Catherine's **before 31 October** and we'll waive the \$125 application fee if you are accepted into our College.

Research

Submit two Referee Report forms

You will need to provide two Referee Report forms in support of your application. Please ask your nominated referees to send the completed Referee Report form directly to the College. Forms can be submitted to our postal address (2 Park Road, Crawley WA 6009), or by email (admissions@stcatherines.uwa.edu.au).

Interview with the Head or Deputy Head of College

Once we have received your online application and Referee Report forms, we will arrange a suitable time with you for an interview. There is no need to be nervous about the interview – it is an opportunity for us to get to know you better, as well as for you to ask us anything and ensure that you know what is expected as a resident at St Catherine's. The interview can be done in person or via telephone if you do not reside in Perth.

Submit application for residency

Complete the online application on the *UWA Residential Colleges Application Portal*, with St Catherine's listed as your first preference. We make offers on a rolling basis and because we are a popular choice, applying early is crucial to securing your place.

Submit an application for a scholarship

Submit an application for a scholarship to live at St Catherine's on our website. We invest \$800,000 annually in a range of residential scholarships and bursaries which provide a substantial discount on your fees. Scholarship applications for 2018 are now open and close on 30 January 2018.

Application outcome

Successful applicants will receive an offer of accommodation. Conditional on your acceptance to university, you will be required to sign a contract and pay a non-refundable fee to secure your place at the College. If you are not successful in your application, the *UWA Residential Colleges Application Portal* will forward your details to your next college of preference.
